Recent [Lynnwood Link](#) design refinements focus on reducing costs without compromising fast, frequent and congestion-free service for riders as the region's population and gridlock keep growing. The 8.5-mile project will connect Shoreline, Mountlake Terrace, Lynnwood and surrounding communities to a regional system that will grow to 116 miles, with service scheduled to begin in 2024 to Seattle, the Eastside, Sea-Tac Airport and Federal Way.
